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APPENDIX A

Australian Register of Homeopaths (ARoH) is a homeopath registration body that sets minimum education standards for Australian homeopaths, accredits homeopathic courses, upholds professional standards and responds to complaints by members of the public. Healthcare professionals are defined as those who have a bachelor degree or advanced diploma in homeopathy or another health science or medical science subject plus post graduate homeopathic studies or its equivalent. This includes homeopaths that also hold current registration with APHRA and Australian veterinary professionals.

Registrants are allocated a tier of registration according to their qualification however this is not a statement of any registrant's ability to practise homeopathy apart from attaining minimum educational qualifications. Registrants must always work within the scope of practice and those registrants with separate APHRA or veterinary registration must maintain the requirements of their regulatory bodies as well as comply with ARoH professional code of conduct.

Registrants are obliged to maintain a level of competence within the scope of their training and qualification in homeopathy and whatever other regulatory requirement. Registrants may increase their practical experience should that be lacking by having some supervision of both practice and theory. They may be given provisional registration during this period but this should be seen as support from ARoH and other senior homeopathic practitioners.

In order to ensure the highest standards of practice, ARoH stipulates all practitioners to engage in annual minimum CPD activity of 20 hours. ARoH has broadened its scope of CPD activities to make this an interesting and enriching process for all registrants. Further guidance for completing this is on ARoH webpage

It is the responsibility of individual practitioners to maintain ARoH standards, and CPD evidence may be requested as part of quality control and auditory checks.

ARoH serves as a standard to support all registered homeopaths and the homeopathic profession, and to ensure public safety. All registrants must comply with ARoH's:
